

RING OF THE MAGICIAN

DESCRIPTION

The Ring of the Magician is a small silver ring set with a dark blue stone with an emblazoned owl etched into it's surface.

When worn, it allows the wearer to peer into darkness and see the past.



*"Through the darkness of future past,
the Magician longs to see."*

DMs NOTES:

The Ring of the Magician is not what it appears to be. A ring, yes, but allowing the wearer to see into the past, no. While the ring does grant the wearing to look into darkness and see the past, it also grants them the ability to visit the past and make changes. The act of getting into the past is a bit tricky and is in no way obvious that the wearer can actually move between the two worlds of the present and the past.

To move into the past, the wearer must recognize that they can. Visually, it will appear that they can only see what has happened, but once they attempt to interact with something in that vision, that is when the ring's true power comes into play and the wearer is immediately transported to that past.

Of course there is an inherent danger in interacting with things in the past as that can greatly alter the future, but that is for the DM to determine.

There are rumors of other Rings of the Magician that exist, each with their own overt magical properties, but like this one, they too likely have a hidden and less obvious magical ability.
